- Standards adoption is an initiative from PIDX Innovation Day 2020
- New Work Group (WG 05) initiated in 2021
- Charter approved by Standards & Guidelines Committee June 25, 2021
- Approved by PIDX Executive Committee August 18, 2021
- Aparna Kakani nominated and elected as Chair January 19, 2022
(confirmed at Annual Member Meeting 2022)
- Kickoff meeting on February 17, 2022



STANDARDS ADOPTION COUNCIL UPDATE

CHARTER

The **Standards Adoption Council** has been established to develop an adoption strategy at the time that a standards project is proposed, including (1) defining real-world use cases the standards seek to solve, (2) setting clear KPIs around standards adoption success, and (3) implementing proof of concepts (POCs) with Project Team participants prior to the voting and approval processes for standardization.

STANDARDS ADOPTION COUNCIL UPDATE

ADVANCE ADOPTION AND IMPLEMENTATION

1. Understand the current standards adoption
2. Understand the real use case and value for a standard definition
3. Get involved at the standard concept definition phase
4. Set KPIs when a standard is published
5. Understand the usage and adoption for a defined standard

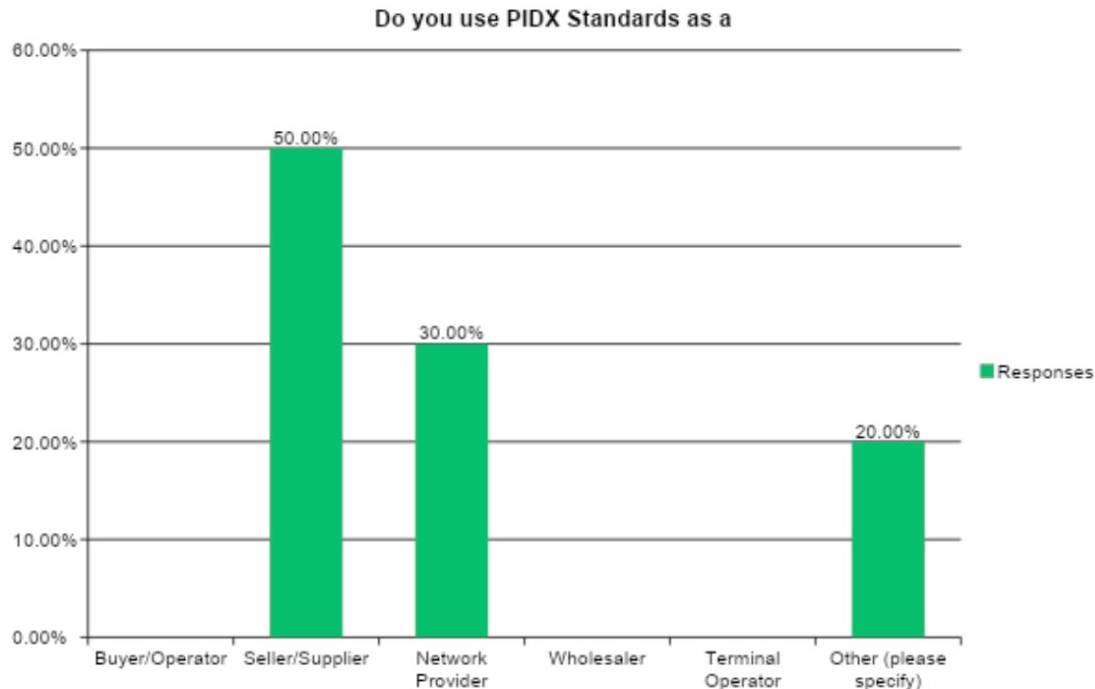

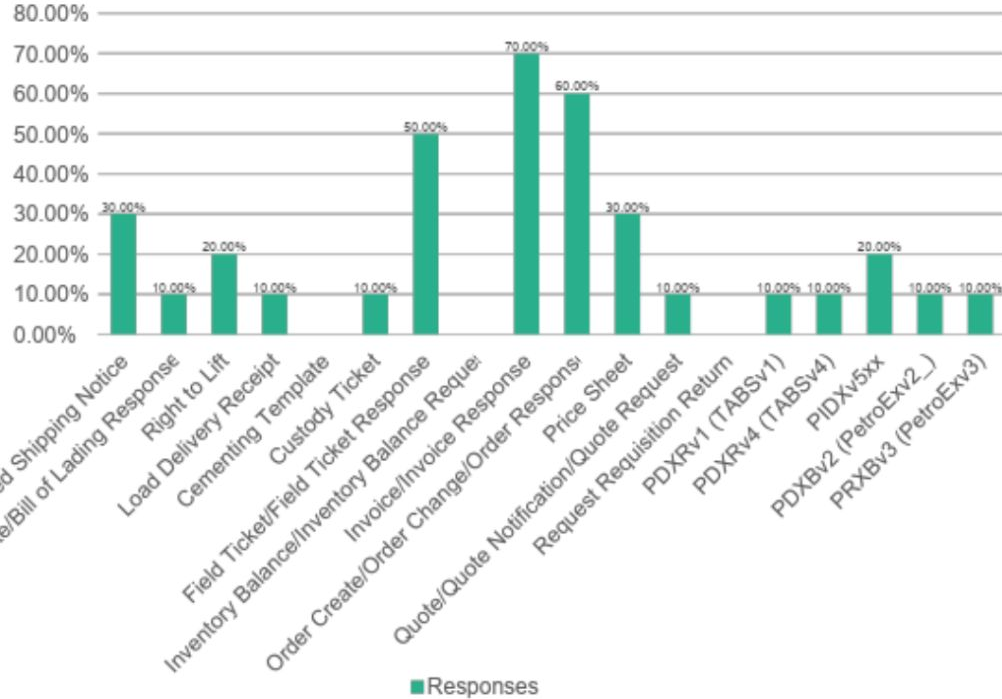

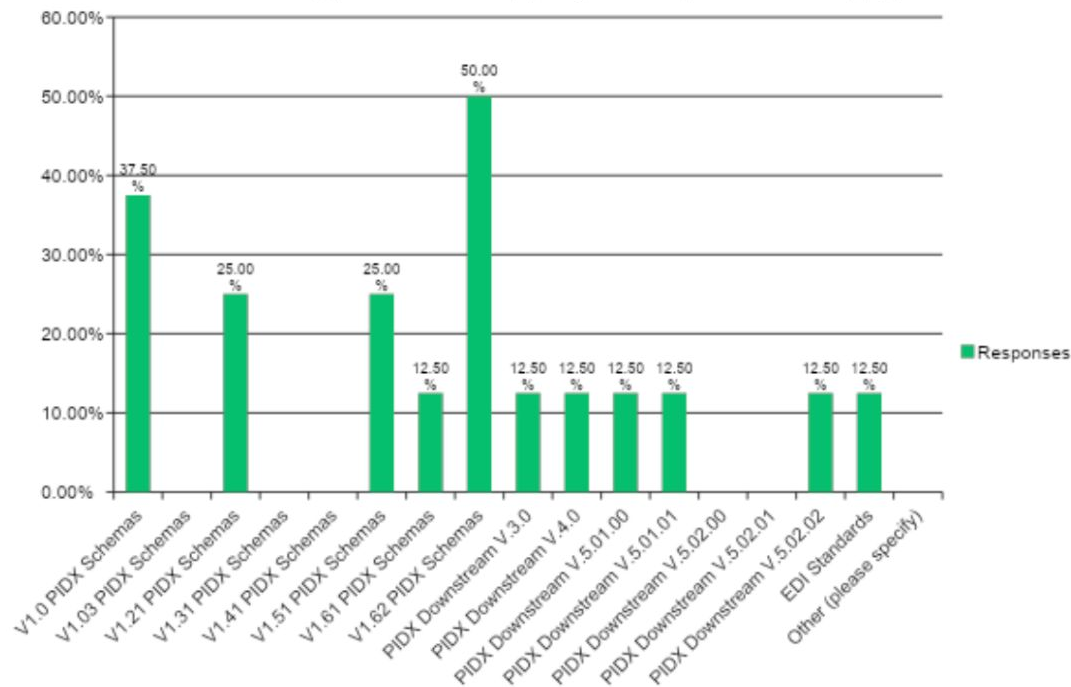

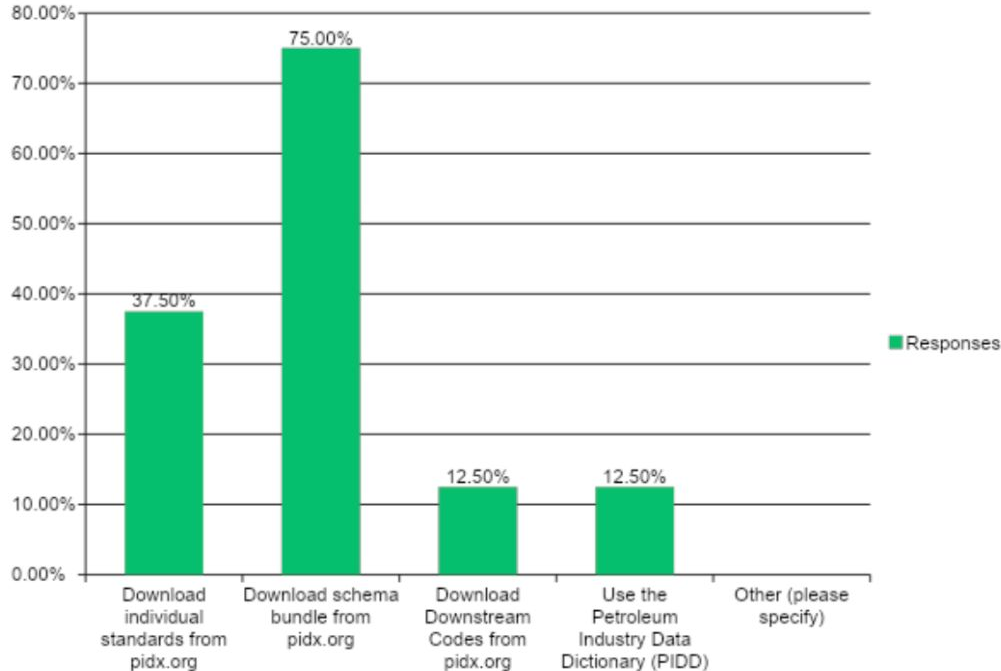

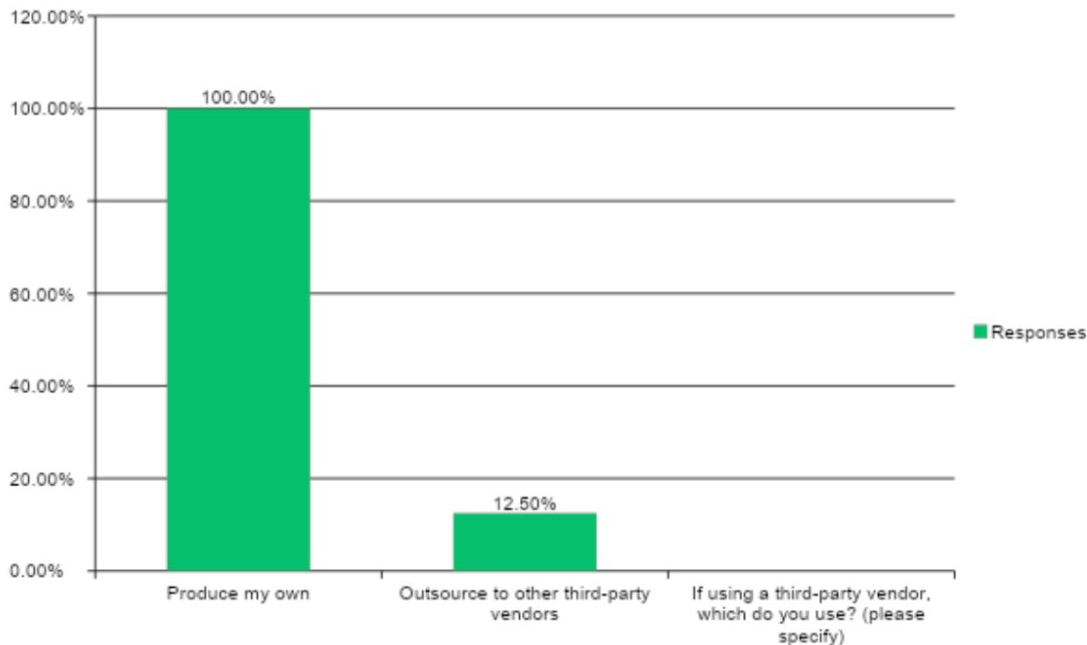

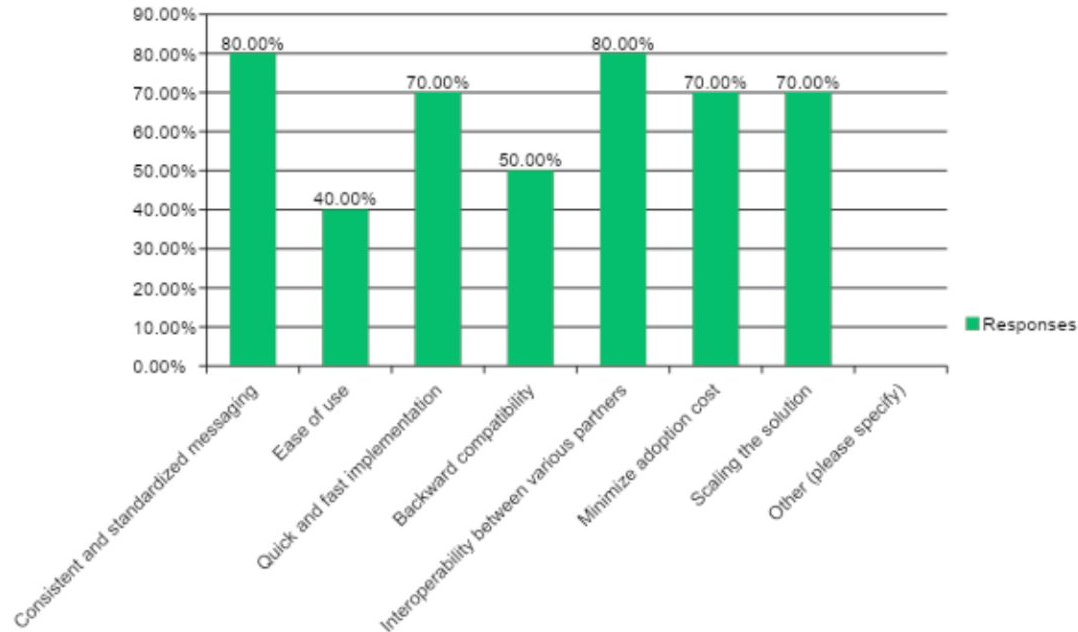

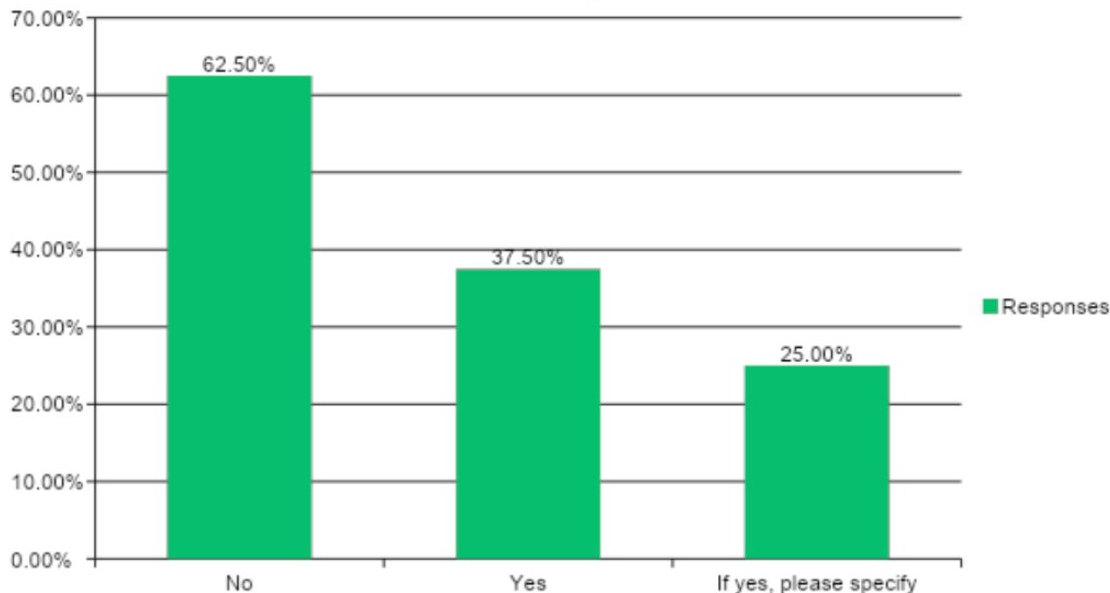

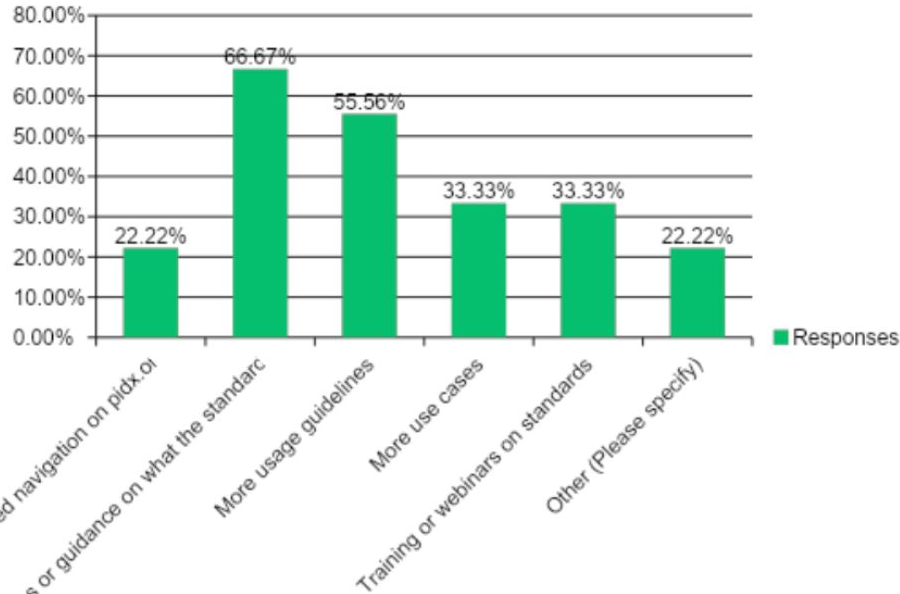

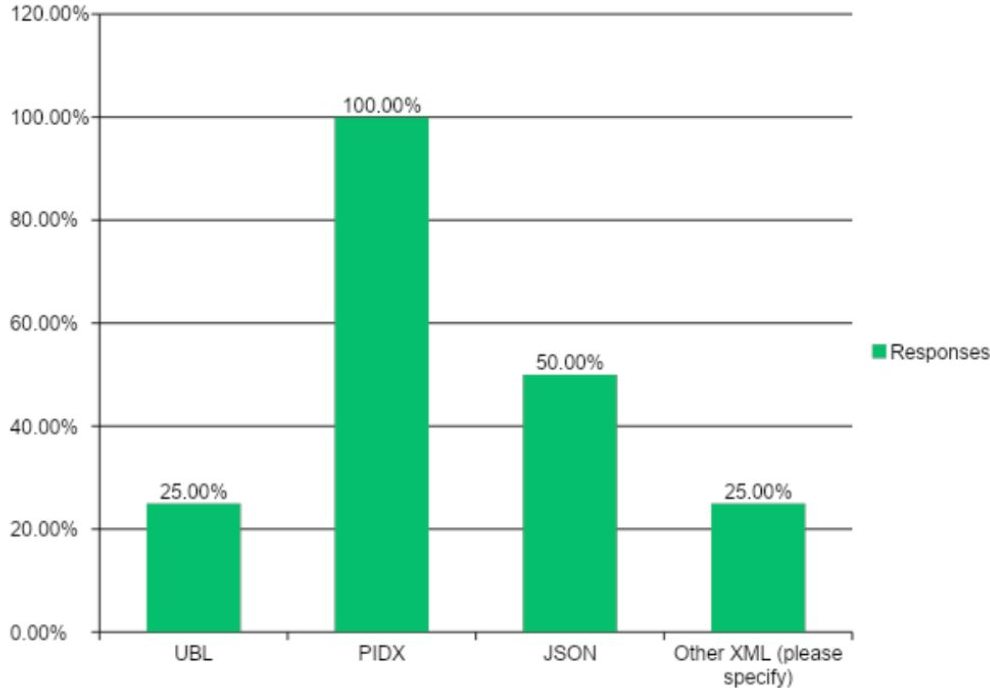

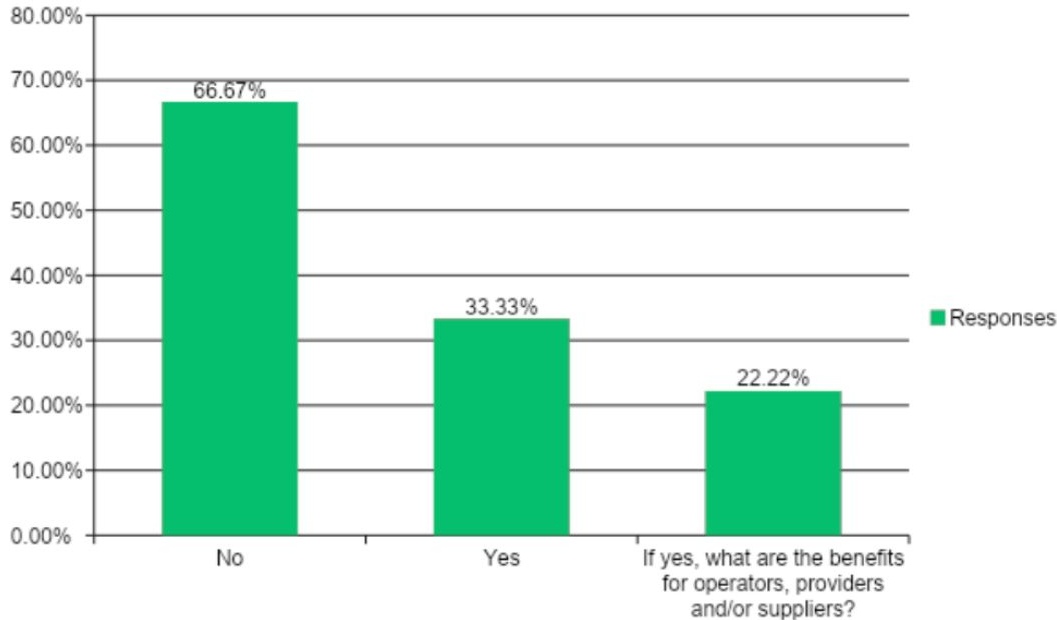

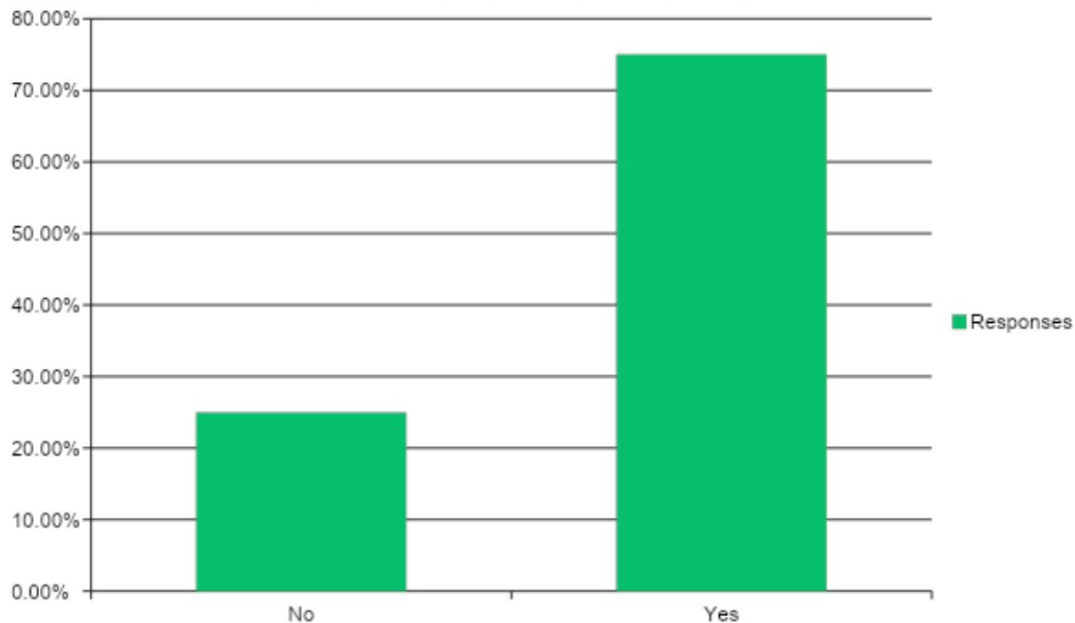

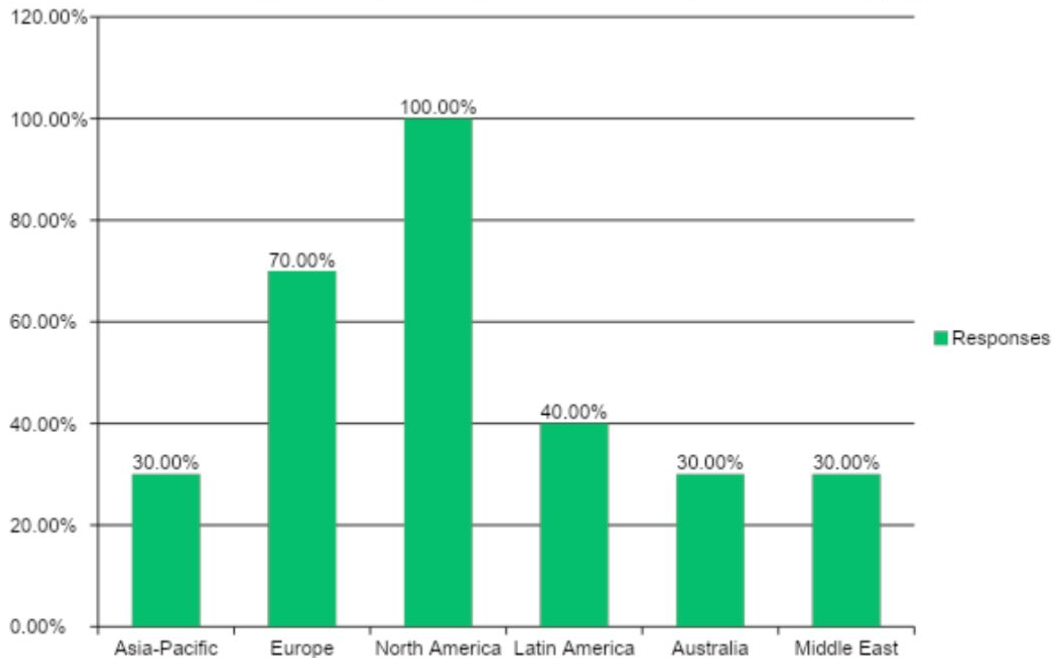
